

## Word Problems

1) Donald Duck has 404 grapes. He wants to put them in bags of 8 grapes each. How many bags can he make, and how many grapes will be left over?

2) Minnie Mouse has 846 cupcakes and she wants to divide them equally among her 8 closest Disney princess friends. How many cupcakes will each princess get, and how many will Minnie Mouse have left?

3) If Dora has 60 stickers and wants to share them equally among her 6 friends, how many stickers will each friend get?

4) Woody and Buzz Lightyear flew 18 miles in 2 days. If they flew the same amount each day, how many miles did they fly each day?

5) Mickey Mouse has 27 balloons. He wants to divide them equally among 4 rooms in his house. How many balloons will be in each room, and how many will be left for Mickey?

6) Superman has 220 Kryptonite crystals and he wants to share them equally among his 3 fellow Justice League members. How many Kryptonite crystals will each member get, and how many will Superman have left?

7) If Spiderman has 16 spiderwebs and wants to divide them equally among himself and 8 other superheroes, how many spiderwebs will each person get?

8) Tweety Bird has 89 bird seeds and wants to distribute them evenly among his 7 friends. How many bird seeds will each friend get, and how many will Tweety have left?

9) Iron Man has 76 missiles, and he wants to divide them into 4 equal groups to put them in his armor. How many missiles will be in each group?

10) Catwoman has 16 cat statues, and she wants to distribute them equally among her 4 cat burglars. How many cat statues will each cat burglar get?

11) Tweety Bird ate 316 birdseeds in 4 days. If he ate the same amount each day, how many birdseeds did he eat each day?

12) If there are 90 candies, and 5 friends want to share them equally, how many candies will each friend get?

13) Elsa has 819 snowflakes, and she wants to share them equally among her 3 friends. How many snowflakes will each friend get?

14) Minnie Mouse bought 604 balloons for Pluto's birthday party. She wants to divide them equally among 5 tables. How many balloons will each table get, and how many balloons will be left over for Minnie to play with?
